Your Legal Requirements

Under the Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations 1998 (PUWER), it is a legal requirement for those involved in the use of abrasive wheels to be properly trained every 3 years. These regulations have totally replaced the Abrasive Wheel Regulations 1970 for the safe handling, storing, mounting and use of abrasive wheels.

In addition, new safety standards for abrasive wheels and grinding machines and new codes of practice for the safe use of these products have also been introduced. This has widened the scope for training to include those manufacturing, specifying, selling, purchasing and supervising the use of abrasive wheels.

Through an active involvement with the abrasive wheel trade associations, standards organisations and safety bodies, Tyrolit is able to provide the most up to date and comprehensive training available in abrasive wheel safety. Tyrolit is an active member of FEPA (Federation of European Producers of Abrasives), BAF (British Abrasives Federation) and oSa (Organisation for Safety of Abrasives).
